The New Paltz Police Department reports the arrest of;

**Wilson M. Davis 22 years old
9810 Southwest Bunker Trail
Vashon, WA 98070**

was arrested by the New Paltz Police Department on March 31st, 2011 at 12pm and
charged with one count of;

- ***Burglary 2nd a class C Felony***

This arrest is a result of an investigation that was started on May 12, 2009, at 0300 hours, New Paltz Police Officers responded to a residence in the Village of New Paltz for a reported home invasion burglary where the victims were injured. Arriving officers interviewed the victims who reported that two subjects had broken into their residence via a fire escape. It was reported that one of the suspects threatened the victims with a handgun before assaulting them. The crime scene was processed by members of the New Paltz Police and evidence was collected for analysis.

Based on further investigation, New Paltz Police Detectives were able to identify Wilson M. Davis. He was identified from DNA evidence that was collected at the crime scene. Wilson M. Davis was indicted for Burglary 2nd by the Ulster County Grand Jury on December 16th, 2010. New Paltz Detectives learned that he was currently living in

Vashon, Washington with relatives. Members of New Paltz Police Department picked up Mr. Davis at the Kings County Jail in Seattle on Thursday morning and he was transported back to New Paltz late Thursday evening. Wilson Davis was remanded to the Ulster County Jail on the Ulster County Court Warrant to await further court proceedings not yet determined.

The New Paltz Police Department was assisted in the investigation by U.S. Federal Marshall's Office, Seattle Police, the New York State Police Crime Laboratory and the Ulster County District Attorney's Office.
